DAILY VOCABULARY LIST

❖ **Inculcate (verb) (अंतर्निविष्ट करना):** (instill an idea, attitude, or habit) by persistent instruction.

Synonyms: Instill, Implant, Fix, Ingrain, Infuse, Imprint, Imbue.

Antonyms: Abstain, Neglect.

Example: In order to **inculcate** a love of reading, the teacher encourages her students to read different types of literature.

❖ **Delinquent (adj.) (विलंबित):** tending to commit crime /failing in one's duty.

Synonyms: Neglectful, Remiss, Derelict, Defaultant.

Antonyms: Dutiful, Careful, Responsible.

Example: The pharmacist would be **delinquent** in his duties if he did not tell you about the drug's adverse effects.

❖ **Guzzle (verb) (गटकना):** Consume fast/ eat or drink (something) greedily.

Synonyms: Gobble (Up), Devour, Wolf, Eat (Hungriily).

Antonyms: Sip, Eat Slowly.

Example: As the waitress brought the soda, she **guzzled** it up before I could stop him.

❖ **Adroit (adj.) (दक्ष):** Clever or skillful.

Synonyms: Skillful, Adept, Dexterous, Deft, Agile, Nimble, Ingenious.

Antonyms: Clumsy, Incompetent, Unskilled, Ignorant.

Example: Because Leonard is **adroit** at mental calculations, he is able to effortlessly solve complicated math problems.

❖ **Hegemonic (Adj.) (आधिपत्य):** Ruling or dominant in a political or social context.

Synonyms: Authoritative, Commanding, Dominant, Ruling.

Antonyms: Subordinate, Inferior.

Example: When the dictator was chased out of the country, his **hegemony** over the people came to an end.
