DAILY VOCABULARY LIST

- ❖ **Culminate (verb) (चरम बिंदु पर पहुंचना):** Reach a climax or point of highest development.
- Synonyms:** Climax, Conclude, End Up, Terminate with, Wind Up.
Antonyms: Begin, Commence, Start.
Example: A tension between the two countries is likely to **culminate** in a war.
- ❖ **Interneccine(adj.)(घातक):** Destructive to both sides in a conflict.
- Synonyms:** Deadly, Fierce, Destructive, Ruinous, Pernicious.
Antonyms: Favorable, Fortunate, Harmless, Healthful.
Example: According to the police, the two gangs recently fought an **interneccine** battle that left both groups with many wounded.
- ❖ **Parlay (verb) (परिणत करना):** Transform into something greater or more valuable.
- Synonyms:** Metamorphose, Construct, Renew, Turn Over A New Leaf.
Antonyms: Stagnate, Stall.
Example: The new tax regime has **parlayed** the Indian tax system completely.
- ❖ **Tenuous (adj.) (महीन):** Very weak or slight.
- Synonyms:** Insubstantial, Flimsy, Weak, Fragile, Nebulous
Antonyms: Firm, Heavy, Strong, Substantial, Healthy, Significant
Example: Because the evidence against her is **tenuous**, the accused murderer will be released from jail on bail.
- ❖ **Tortuous (Adj.) (पेचीदा):** Full of twists and turns.
- Synonyms:** Convoluted, Roundabout, Circuitous, Sinuous, Undulating, Coiling.
Antonyms: Straightforward, Uncomplicated, Untwisted.
Example: With the sign showing a **tortuous** road up ahead, we realized that we were traveling down the bends of the mountain.
