DAILY VOCABULARY LIST

- ❖ **Poodle (noun) (अनुपालक):** A person or organization who is overly willing to obey another.
- Synonyms:** Compliant, Obedient, Duteous, Tractable.
Antonyms: Stubborn, Unyielding, Recalcitrant.
Example: Everyone considered him as a **poodle**, but appointing him as a team Manager astounded everyone.
- ❖ **Hardwired (adj.) (अंतर्निहित):** Genetically or innately determined.
- Synonyms:** Built-In, Constitutional, Constitutive, Essential, Inherent, Immanent.
Antonyms: Extrinsic.
Example: Humans are **hard-wired** to feel good when they're altruistic.
- ❖ **Sloth (noun) (निष्क्रियता):** Reluctance to work or make an effort.
- Synonyms:** Laziness, Idleness, Indolence, Inactivity, Sluggishness, Accidie.
Antonyms: Busyness, Energy, Liveliness, Vigor.
Example: His overly lax managerial style has resulted in a **slothful** and unproductive environment in the organization. .
- ❖ **Ambit (noun) (सीमा):** A sphere of operation or influence; range
- Synonyms:** Limit, Range, Border, Boundary, Scope
Antonyms: Limitless, Extension, Infinity
Example: I saw for the first time a horizon as an arc suggesting how wide is our **ambit**.
- ❖ **Crisp (adj.) (भंगुर):** (Of a substance) firm, dry, and brittle
- Synonyms:** Brittle, Fragile, Destructible, Frail
Antonyms: Flexible, Soft, Temperate
Example: She swallowed down a **crisp** reply.
