DAILY VOCABULARY LIST

❖ **Stifle (Verb) (दबाना) : Restrain (A Reaction) Or Stop Oneself Acting On**

Synonyms : Suppress, Smother, Restrain.

Antonyms : Allow, Release, Assist, Encourage,

Example : Some Medical Researchers Believe The Reduction Of Animal Testing Will Have A **Stifling** Effect On Drug Innovation.

❖ **Sacrosanct (Adj) (रक्षणीय) : Too Important Or Respected To Be Criticized Or Changed**

Synonyms : Inviolable, Unimpeachable, Unchallengeable.

Antonyms : Profane, Unsacred

Example : During The Financial Meeting, The Company President Reminded Everyone That No Department Was Too **Sacrosanct** To Avoid A Cut In Its Yearly Budget.

❖ **Complicit (Adj) (सह-अपराधी) : Involved With Others In An Activity That Is Unlawful**

Synonyms : Conniving, Conspiring, Colluding.

Antonyms : Clear, Honest, Straightforward.

Example : Your **Complicity** In The Crime Is Probably Going To Earn You Five Years In Prison.

❖ **Jinx (Verb)(अभाग्य) : Bring Bad Luck To; Cast An Evil Spell On.**

Synonyms : Bewitch, Hoodoo, Hex.

Antonyms : Boon, Luck, Advantage.

Example : His Luck Has Been So Bad He Feels **Jinxed**.

❖ **Articulate (Verb) (स्पष्ट रूप से कहना) : Express Clearly And Distinctly.**

Synonyms : Express Distinctly, Say Lucidly.

Antonyms : Unclear, Vaguely Represent.

Example : The President Is Known For His Ability To **Articulate** His Thoughts In Front Of Millions Of People.
