DAILY VOCABULARY LIST

❖ **Gingerly (adv.) (सतर्कता से):** In a careful or cautious manner.

Synonyms: Cautiously, Carefully, With Caution, With Care, Circumspectly.

Antonyms: Carelessly, Un-Cautiously, Uncarefully.

Example: After the dentist had done his work, she had to chew **gingerly** on that side of her mouth for a while.

❖ **Rein (verb) (नियंत्रण):** Keep under control; restrain.

Synonyms: Command, Curb, Subjugate, Subordinate, Subdue

Antonyms: Release, Discharge, Liberation

Example: She forced herself to **rein** in her excitement.

❖ **Dovetail (verb) (मेल खाना):** Fit or cause to fit together easily and conveniently.

Synonyms: Accord, Concur, Coincide, Match, Fit, Be in agreement, Conform.

Antonyms: Clash, Mismatch, Disunite.

Example: For any relation to be successful, the habits of both sides should be **dovetailed**.

❖ **Unfettered (adj.) (निरंकुश/ मुक्त):** Not confined or restricted.

Synonyms: Emancipate, Free, Liberated, Released

Antonyms: Banned, Restricted, Conditioned, Parochial

Example: The topless Jeep offered an **unfettered** view of the spectacular scenery.

❖ **Sinew (noun) (सामर्थ्य):** The parts of a structure, system, or organization that give it strength or bind it together.

Synonyms: Muscle, Potency, Power, Vigor.

Antonyms: Disability, Impotence, Lethargy, Powerlessness, Weakness.

Example: A captain should be **sinew** of his team.
