DAILY VOCABULARY LIST

❖ **Coercive (adj.) (बलपूर्वक):** Relating to or using force or threats.

Synonyms: Intimidating, Forceful, Violent, Helplessness

Antonyms: Humble, Conditional, Lenient, Discretionary

Example: The government, however, saw little reason in the events of the following months for reversing their **coercive** policy.

❖ **Thaw (noun) (पिघलना):** An increase in friendliness or cordiality.

Synonyms: Fuse, Dissolve, Melt, mollify, Necrose

Antonyms: Coagulate, Condense, Freeze, Solidify

Example: She held the coffee cup tightly, trying to **thaw** her frozen fingers.

❖ **Pragmatism (noun) (व्यवहारवाद):** An approach that evaluates theories or beliefs in terms of the success of their practical application.

Synonyms: Aptness, Practicality, Utilitarianism, Veritism

Antonyms: Inappropriateness, Disadvantage

Example: One direct result of this **pragmatism** was unexpected.

❖ **Inclusion (noun) (समावेश):** The action or state of including or of being included within a group or structure.

Synonyms: Admittance, Formation, Incorporation, Insertion

Antonyms: Subtraction, Exclusion

Example: This scheme must allow of the Council selecting at least a majority of the committee, and must provide for the **inclusion** of experts and women.

❖ **Provocation (Noun) (उकसावा):** Action or speech that makes someone angry, especially deliberately.

Synonyms: Prompting, Provoking, Instigation, Insinuation, Inducement

Antonyms: Compliment, Discouragement, Prevention, Repression, Suppression

Example: He can turn violent at the least **provocation**.
