DAILY VOCABULARY LIST

❖ **Dysfunctional (adj.) (त्रुटिपूर्ण):** Not operating normally or properly.

Synonyms: Malfunctional, Flawed, Defective, Maladjusted.

Antonyms: Apt, Fitting, Apropos, Apposite.

Example: Family **dysfunction** led to drug use by the oldest son and a life of crime for the youngest.

❖ **Devolve (verb) (हस्तांतरित होना):** Transfer or delegate (power) to a lower level

Synonyms: Delegate, Pass (Down/On), Hand Down/Over/On, Depute, Transfer.

Antonyms: Take Own.

Example: Because Janice cannot do all of the tasks, she has to learn to **devolve** work to her employees.

❖ **Dissuade (verb) (न करनेके लिए समझाना):** Persuade (someone) not to take a particular course of action.

Synonyms: Disincline, Turn Aside, Divert, Sidetrack.

Antonyms: Encourage, Persuade.

Example: Since James is a stubborn man, he does not let anyone **dissuade** him from doing what he wants to do.

❖ **Unease (noun) (व्यग्रता):** A sense of anxiety or discontent.

Synonyms: Anxiety, Disquiet, Instability, Turbulence, Unrest.

Antonyms: Calmness, Peace, Happiness, Tranquility.

Example: You may feel a bit of **unease** before your first interview with a potential employer, but try to make it so your nervousness isn't obvious.

❖ **Shrill (adj.) (कर्कश):** Loud and forceful.

Synonyms: High-Pitched, Piercing, High, Sharp, powerful, impactful.

Antonyms: Calm, Low, Mild, Moderate

Example: The piercing barking of dogs **shrilled** through the night.
