



India Becomes 3rd Largest Electricity Producer In The World

- ❖ India has become the 3rd largest electricity producer in the world as its electricity production grew 34% over seven years to 2017. The country now produces more energy than Japan and Russia, which had 27% and 8.77% more electricity generation capacity installed, respectively, than India seven years ago. Electricity production stood at 1,003.525 Billion Unit between April 2017-January 2018, according to a February 2018 report by India Brand Equity Foundation (IBEF), a trust established by the commerce ministry. With a production of 1,423 BU in FY 2016, India was the third largest producer and the third largest consumer of electricity in the world, behind China (6,015 BU) and the United States (4,327 BU).

India Is Now The 4th Largest Automobile Market Globally

- ❖ According to the latest 2018 global data show, India has overtaken Germany and has become the fourth largest automobile market in the world. As the statistics show, the automobile sales grew by 9.5 percent, which, is the fastest growth rate among major global markets. China is the largest Auto Market globally.

ISA And India Sign Host Country Agreement

- ❖ The International Solar Alliance (ISA) and the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), signed the Host Country Agreement. The Agreement will give ISA a juridical personality and gives it power to contract, to acquire and dispose off movable and immovable properties, to institute and defend legal proceedings. Under this agreement, ISA shall enjoy such privileges, applicable tax concessions and immunities as are necessary for ISA's Headquarter to independently discharge its function and programmes.

Print Biennale India 2018: First International Exhibition Held in New Delhi

- ❖ With the participation of 17 countries, Lalit Kala Akademi of New Delhi hosted the very first International Print Biennale of India. The prime focus of the event was to discover new trends in print making nationally and internationally. A total of 200 original prints created by Indian and international artists of impeccable competence were the in the highlights and is a window view into the giant strides in printmaking that is taking place in India and the world. The participants came from countries such as USA, UK, Sri Lanka, Italy, Mexico, China, Israel, Sweden, Lithuania, Poland, Argentina, Greece, Nepal, Bangladesh, and Mauritius. A total number of 988 entries at the national level were received of which 127 have been chosen for display.

Chhattisgarh bags 'Water Digest Award' for water conservation

- ❖ Chhattisgarh bagged the National 'Water Digest Award' for Water Conservation-Diversion and for increasing the irrigation capacity in the State. This is the first time that Chhattisgarh Water Resources Department had been given national Award during the past 17 years. The Award is presented every year by globally renowned magazine 'Water Digest'-which focuses mainly on water resources.

Surat first district to have 100% solar powered health centres

- ❖ Surat has become the first district in the country to have 100 percent solar powered Primary Health Centers (PHC). There are a total of 52 PHCs in the district and all of them are now powered by solar system. This initiative will not only bring down the electricity bill by 40 percent but also help fight global warming.

London based organisation SACF wins Frederick Pincott Award for 2017

- ❖ South Asian Cinema Foundation (SACF), a London based organisation has received the Frederick Pincott Award for 2017 from the Indian High Commissioner, Y K Sinha for promoting Hindi cinema in Britain for the last 18 years. The institution has been active in boosting original research and books on Indian films, also inviting and honouring filmmakers from India. The SACF was set up in London in January 2000 by Lalit Mohan Joshi, along with film archivist P K Nair.

'Economy to double to \$5 tn by 2025'


- ❖ India is on track to doubling the size of its economy to USD 5 trillion by 2025, the finance ministry said while asserting that the inflation target set by the Reserve Bank will not be breached. The country is well poised to click a growth rate of 7-8 per cent and with focus on start-ups, MSMEs and infrastructure investment it can step on to higher growth pedestal, Economic Affairs Secretary Subhash Chandra Garg said. India's GDP in value terms currently stands at USD 2.5 trillion—making it the sixth largest economy in the world.
