After 25 years, Manik Sarkar steps down as Tripura CM

- ❖ Tripura Chief Minister Manik Sarkar tendered his resignation to Governor Tathagata Roy, who asked him to continue in office till the next Chief Minister takes over. The BJP-IPFT coalition has swept the polls, winning 43 of the 59 seats for which elections were held. The BJP secured 35 seats in the 60-member assembly while its ally IPFT, a tribal based party, has won eight seats.

CCEA Doubles Bank Guarantee Limit for Pulses and Oilseeds for NAFED

- ❖ Chaired by PM Modi, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has given its approval to give guarantee of Rs. 1900 crore to National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India (NAFED) for obtaining credit from banks for procurement operation of pulses and oilseeds under Price Support Scheme (PSS). Earlier the limit was Rs. 9500 which has been doubled now. For Small Farmers Agri-Business Consortium (SFAC) the guarantee limit of Rs. 45 crore has been approved. These Government Guarantees are provided for a period of five years i.e. till 2021-22 by Govt. of India and with waiver of 1% Government Guarantee fee.

National Safety Day: 4 March

- ❖ National Safety Day is a Day which is used to make every people get safe from many issues such as Financial Loss, Health problems and also any types of problems in the life of the citizens. It is used to celebrate to become more secure from the activities which reflect and change the situation of the people in many ways evil as well as good ways. It is celebrated on the 4th March every year in India by the National Safety Council of India.

Shooter Rizvi wins World Cup gold

- ❖ Indian shooter Shahzar Rizvi created a new world record on his way to the gold medal in the men's 10m air pistol event at the ISSF World Cup. Rizvi registered a world record score of 242.3 points in the final. The Indian beat reigning Olympic champion Christian Reitz of Germany, who had to settle for the silver. India's Jitu Rai bagged the bronze with 219.

Conrad Sangma Will be the Next CM of Meghalaya

- ❖ In Meghalaya, NPP chief Conrad K Sangma met Governor Ganga Prasad and submitted the letter of support from other parties. The swearing-in of Conrad as the chief minister will take place on March 5. In Tripura, the government formation process is expected to be completed by March 10.

Trafficking of Persons Bill, 2018 Approved by Cabinet

- ❖ The Union Cabinet of India has given its nod to the Trafficking of Persons (Prevention, Protection and Rehabilitation) Bill, 2018 for introduction in Parliament. Human Trafficking is considered to be the third largest organised crime that violates basic human right and India has no specific law to deal with this issue. Therefore this bill was prepared to curb this crime which is quite widespread in India yet it is not recognised most of the time. Women and children are most affected by human trafficking. The Bill has been prepared in consultation with line Ministries, Departments, State Governments, NGOs and domain experts. Ministry of WCD received many petitions to be incorporated in the bill. The draft of the bill was consulted in Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai Bombay with various stakeholders including over 60 NGOs. The Bill was examined and discussed by Group of Ministers also.

Odisha govt launches 'Ama Gaon, Ama Vikas' programme


- ❖ The Odisha government has launched a programme Ama Gaon, Ama Vikas (Our Village, our development) to reach out to the people in rural areas and involve themselves in the developmental activities. Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik flagged off mobile video vans for 'Ama Gaon Ama Vikas' programme that will move across the State to highlight various welfare schemes at villages in the state. He said this initiative administration will help people in solving their grievances instantly.

India's first Aviation Multi Skill Development Centre launched in Chandigarh

- ❖ In the presence of Union Minister of Civil Aviation P Ashok Gajapathi Raju, Chandigarh MP Kirron Kher and Anandpur Sahib MP Prem Singh Chandumajra, India's first Aviation Multi Skill Development Centre was inaugurated at Chandigarh Airport's old terminal. The centre built with an aim to train youngsters will help the civil aviation sector's growth. Initially, 2400 youths will be trained here in eight aviation job roles over the next three years. A great response was witnessed among the aspirants to join the centre as the students will be trained
