



### **1st commercial flight of Arunachal Pradesh under UDAN scheme**

- ❖ Arunachal Pradesh hosted its first commercial flight under the Udan scheme of the Central Government. Its first fixed-wing commercial aircraft was flagged off from Pasighat to Guwahati by Chief Minister Pema Khandu. The Air India Ltd agreed to start ATR-42 services of Alliance Air to Pasighat from Gopinath Bordoloi airport at Guwahati, connecting the state with rest of the country. The 42-seat Alliance Air ATR will fly between Guwahati and Pasighat thrice a week as of now. Alliance Air, which is a subsidiary of Air India, Zoom Air and Turbo Jet are also set to commence services in the state as soon as the formalities are completed.

### **Full Delhi Metro Magenta Line to open for public from May 29**

- ❖ The portion of Delhi Metro's Magenta Line which will connect Kalkaji Mandir to Janakpuri West will be open for public from May 29, it was announced today. This section, comprising of 16 stations, will be the longest opened so far in Delhi Metros Phase 3.

### **MP Govt. launched 'My MP Rojgar Portal'**

- ❖ Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan launched 'My MP Rojgar Portal' in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. The portal was launched as a part of the 'Ham Chhu Lenge Asman' Mukhyamantri Career Counselling programme 'Pahal' in a school in Bhopal. It was prepared by the Madhya Pradesh Skill Development and Employment Generation Board under youth empowerment mission. It aims to provide jobs to youths as per their educational qualification, skills and interest and to ensure the availability of able candidates to employers as per need of their business. Therefore the portal will enable the user to choose the place of employment, job sector and job role.

### **South Korea Wins Asian Champions Trophy 2018**

- ❖ The Indian women's Hockey team failed to defend its crown at the fifth Asian Champions Trophy, as it lost to hosts South Korea, 0-1 in the summit clash at Donghae City, South Korea. A goal by Youngsil Lee clinched the Korean team as the winner of Champions Trophy.

### **26th BASIC Ministerial meeting of Environment Ministers in Durban**

- ❖ The 26th BASIC Ministerial Meeting of Environment Ministers was held in Durban, South Africa for co-operation to protect the climate for present and future generations. The BASIC grouping is a bloc of four countries – Brazil, South Africa, India and China – formed by an agreement on November 28, 2009.

## International Bio-diversity Day: 22 May

- ❖ The International Bio-diversity Day is observed on 22nd May every year to increase understanding and awareness of biodiversity issues. The theme for this year is, 'Celebrating 25 Years of Action for Biodiversity'. 2018 marks the 25th anniversary of the entry into force of the Convention on Biological Diversity and to highlight progress made in the achievement of its objectives at the national and global levels.

## GDP growth in Q4 of FY18 seen at 7.4%: Icra

- ❖ Rating agency Icra expects GDP growth in January-March 2017-18 at 7.4 per cent on account of good rabi crop harvest and improved corporate earnings, up from 7.2 per cent in the third quarter. The Central Statistics Office (CSO) is scheduled to come out with GDP estimate for the fourth quarter (Q4) of fiscal 2017-18 and provisional annual estimates for the year 2017-18 on May 31. As per Icra, the growth of the Indian gross value added (GVA) at basic prices in year-on-year (YoY) terms is likely to record a considerable recovery to 7.3 per cent in Q4 FY2018.

## Iraq to host first international football tournament

- ❖ Iraq is to host a West Asia Football Federation championship in the southern city of Basra in November, the first international tournament to be staged in the country since the 1990s. World football's governing body FIFA has lifted a three-decade ban on Iraq hosting international football, this March.

## SBI net loss widens to Rs 7,718 cr in Q4

- ❖ State Bank of India's net loss widened to Rs 7,718 crore in the fourth quarter ended March 31, 2018 against Rs 3,442 crore in the year-ago quarter. Total provisions, including towards loan loss, rose to Rs 23,601 crore from Rs 20,751 crore in the year-ago quarter. Gross non-performing assets rose to Rs 2,23,427 crore as at March-end 2018 against Rs 1,77,866 crore as at March end 2017.

## Yogi Adityanath lays foundation of college, stadium in Gorakhpur

- ❖ Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath today laid the foundation of a degree college and a stadium named after his spiritual guru, Mahant Avaidyanath, in Jungle Kaudia area in Gorakhpur.
